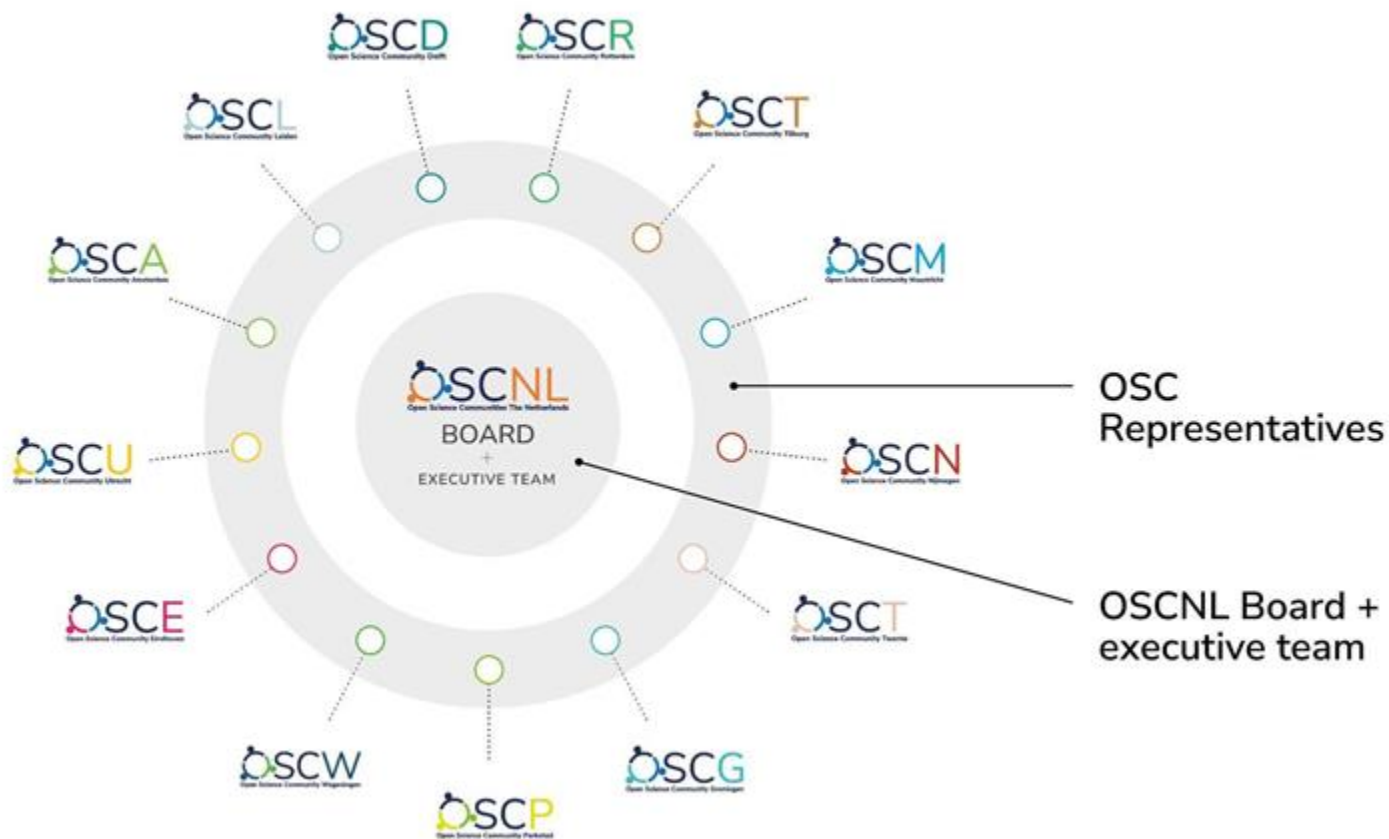

- Elected by OSC members (Assembly)

Executive Team

- Supporting the board
- (Paid) positions, funded for [defined tasks](#)

Advisory Committee

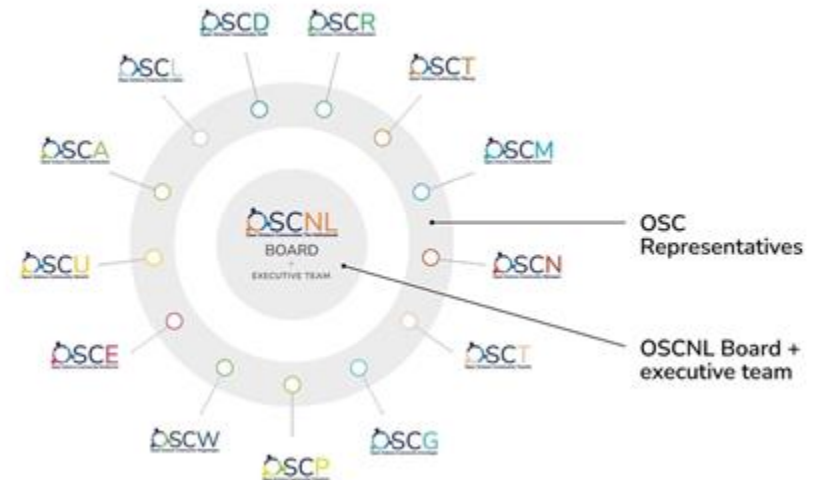
- Advises the Board
- Board decides who to invite

- Elected by representatives

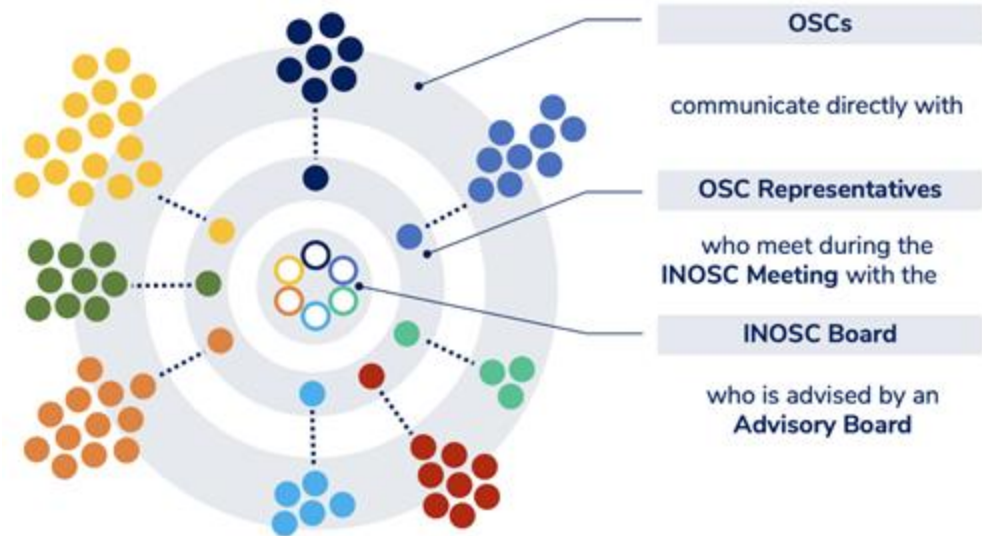
Advisory Board
